From your pastor,

Thanks so much for your prayers and understanding during the last couple of weeks as I mourned the death of my good friend Msgr. Robert Gass.

I have now passed my first year as your pastor. I have been told by my priest friends to first observe activities in a parish before making any changes. I have lived in this parish off and on for 14 years. So I, as pastor, will be making some important decisions which are the following:

1. The rectory first and second floor will be for the exclusive use of the priests and guests of the parish house. No one will have a key to this part of the house except for the priests and authorized personnel of the parish. The locks on doors will be changed for these areas for the sake of the privacy and security of the priests.
2. The Clairvaux Center will continue to be used as it is now. Access to it and exit will remain the same.
3. Privacy of the priests who live in the rectory will be respected by everyone in the parish community.
4. The parish secretary and receptionist will remain in the office wing between the parish house and the church building.
5. Pat Malcolm and the Liturgy office will be moving to another location in the school building.
6. Sharon Perrigo and the bookkeeping office will be moving to another location at the parish.
7. These changes will not be put in place overnight, but throughout the course of this summer.

I appreciate in advance everyone's cooperation and support in this effort.
