*From your pastor,*

I would like to wish everyone a very special Independence Day. As Americans, this day is very important to us. We recall today the history of our nation's origin and the fundamental principles enshrined in the Declaration of Independence.

In regard to another matter, I would like to answer this Sunday a frequent question by a few in the parish. They ask the following, "Why must we not sing the name "Yahweh", in our music? Why do our song books now use the word God or Lord instead of Yahweh?"

Yahweh is the sacred name of God who is holy. In the Jewish tradition this name was never spoken. No one actually knew exactly how to pronounce this sacred name. Jews used the word Lord instead of Yahweh out of respect to the sacred name. Only Moses at the burning bush heard God speak and reveal his sacred name.

Why did they do this? To the Jews, to name something or someone, gives you a power over the thing named. To use a name is also a way of commanding someone's attention. Thus, Adam named all the creatures of the earth. Parents give names to children, etc. Folks call out a name to get someone's attention. So, to give God a name and to pronounce it out loud would be a grave sin in the Jewish tradition. It would be much like an unauthorized person entering the Holy of Holies in the most sacred part of the temple in Jerusalem. Such a person would be killed because they had defiled the holy space.

We as Christians and Catholics are people of the common book of the bible. Our tradition has taken many beliefs and traditions from the Jewish tradition. "Yahweh" was never pronounced in music until the time shortly after Vatican II in some English music.

The Vatican and our Archbishop Lucas have ordered that "Yahweh" is not to be used in music in church. We must obey this directive in all music used at St. Bernard's Church.
