

Foundation Award recipients will be known for their commitment, dedication, faith, and above all, for their love of St. Bernard.

Sue and John Keyser are great stewards of the Catholic faith. Their family, their jobs, and their hobbies are all led from their faith. They are always thinking of others and helping out wherever and however they can.

John's love of St. Bernard's started in grade school, and has never faltered over all of these years. John graduated in 1976, and during his years in school he made lifelong friends. Two of his favorite St. Bernard School memories are: Sr. Carlin always saying "People who use curse words are not intelligent enough to think of other words", and learning to never tilt back on just two legs of a chair (because if you did so in Mr. Gilligan's class, you would have to spend some time in the chair that had the front legs cut off.)

St Bernard has been like a family to the Keyzers. They enjoy going to church where generations of families have attended. Even though the church interior has been remodeled three different times since John's family joined, the heart of the church remains the same. John was an altar boy while in school, and because of the guitar Masses of the '70s (which inspired him to learn guitar) he has provided guitar music for Masses. John is

And Sue is right in the trenches, whether it’s helping serve at our parish Fish Fry or the Siena Francis House homeless shelter, or painting faces at the parish carnival. Even though this year is a strange one, we praise God every day for being able to open at full capacity. Our students and staff have had to adapt what the school day looks like, but we are so grateful that we all get to walk into our building every day.

This year we have welcomed 42 new students and our current enrollment is 152. I hope to see this number rise in the future as we continue to promote our school. We have also welcomed new staff members to our Tiger family. Danielle O’Neill, our new third grade teacher, has done a brilliant job of balancing work and home as she just recently had a baby! Tyler Wheelock, our new PE/STEAM/Health teacher has taken on numerous hats and is always willing to help. We have also welcomed two new evening custodians and maintenance staff, Anthony and Marcus Douglas, who have dedicated their time to making our school pristine. I thank not only our new staff but our returning staff for being flexible and accommodating during my transition into the principal position and also during COVID-19.

The precautions we have taken to prevent the spread of the virus are still in effect. We continue to take temperatures daily, wear masks, social distance, maintain double ventilation in our classrooms, eat lunch in our classrooms, increase cleaning and hand hygiene efforts, and limit visitors. We pray that with these measures we can help stop the spread and get back to our normal day as quickly as possible.

This summer with the help of Dinner Auction funds we were able to renovate three classrooms that look absolutely incredible. Each received new flooring, ceiling, and lights. We also got a new gym roof and a refurbished gym floor, which I hope all of you will be able to see soon! We have also been able to buy new technology and software for our teachers, so that our students can practice skills that they will need in order to be successful as 21st century learners.

While we can’t give tours right now, we are always willing to take phone calls to answer any questions you may have. Thank you for all you are doing to support our school.




